# 2017 Season Outlook with Coach Bennett

## How is the team shaping up?

"The team is really working hard to reach all of our goals. Our short term goals are to get better daily and they are absolutely working hard to achieve that goal."

## What are your expectations for the Team?

"My expectation is to encourage the team to trust the process."

## Are there any early stand outs on the team?

"We have some strong returners from last year. Our pitcher Addie Jensen comes with valuable experience from pitching at Nationals last year. She is a great leader in the classroom, in the locker room, and on the field. We have two returning starters from last year who lead the infield in Kaylee Bott and Madison Sisco. # Head Coach

## Cyndee Bennett

Cyndee Bennett enters her third season as head coach of the powerhouse Bruin Softball program. Prior to becoming head coach, Bennett spent six seasons as an assistant with the program, primarily focusing on the Bruin pitching staff.

Last season, the Bruins racked up a stellar 48-9 overall record resulting in a Scenic West Athletic Conference (SWAC) Championship and a Region 18 Championship. Last season, on April 8th the Bruins were named the #1 team in the nation which they held onto through the final poll of the season. Salt Lake clinched a Nationals birth, but fell to Temple College to end their season.

For their performance on the field, seven Bruins were tabbed as Region 18 selections including five first team selections in KyRae Kogianes, Riana Splinter, Baylee Reeves, Rae Gall, and Megan Reed and two second team selections Karly Bunderson and Corinne Cleverly. On top of these accolades Coach Bennett was named the Region 18 Coach of the Year. Her crew achieved the Region 18 Player of the Year in KyRae Kogianes and Pitcher of the Year in Baylee Reeves. On top of all of the honors, Coach Bennett secured two All-Americans. Riana Splinter was named Second-Team All-American and KyRae Kogianes was named Third-Team All-American.

Under the watch of Coach Bennett, the Bruins combined to hit .358 as team with an astounding 56 homeruns last season. The pitching staff combined for a 2.00 earned run average (ERA) while pulling out a near 3:1 strikeout to walk ratio.

Bennett taught at Olympus High School and was the head coach of Titan Softball for six years before accepting the head coaching position at SLCC. She also coached at Viewmont High School from 1998-2003.

Cyndee was named Coach of the Year by the Utah High School Softball Coaches Association in 2002, 2003 and in 2010. She also coached at the high school level in Las Vegas, NV at Rancho High School from 2004-05 and at her alma-mater Glendale High School in Glendale, CA in 2006 and 2007.

Cyndee has also coached the likes of NJCAA First Team All-American Ariel Zimmerman, a standout pitcher who moved on to Southern Utah University. Several more NJCAA All-Americans have played under Coach Bennett, including shortstop Maddy Woodard (Second Team NJCAA All-American, NJCAA All-Tournament Team 2013), outfielder Malia Campos (NJCAA First Team All-American 2012, NJCAA Second Team All-American, NJCAA All-Tournament Team, NJCAA Most Outstanding Offensive Player 2013), and Cyd Allen (Diamond Sports Catcher of the Year, NJCAA First Team All-American 2010) among many others.

Bennett played softball collegiately at the University of Utah, where she still owns several records that stand today. She was twice selected as an All-Conference player and hails from Glendale, CA.

## Assistant Coach Tara Bendt

Coach Tara Bendt enters her third season as the lead assistant coach for the nationally-renowned SLCC Softball program. Last season, she helped Head Coach Cyndee Bennett and the SLCC softball team to a Scenic West Athletic Conference (SWAC) and Region 18 Championship with a 48-9 overall record. Salt Lake gained a Nationals birth and she coached two All-Americans from the squad. Coach Bendt was named the 2015 National Fastpitch Coaches Association (NFCA) NJCAA Assistant Coach of the Year.

Prior to coming to SLCC, Coach Bendt served as an assistant coach at Utah Valley University where she helped lead the Wolverines to a third place finish in the Pacific Coast Softball Conference with the most wins in school history with a 35-20 overall record in 2013.

She worked as a volunteer assistant at the University of Nevada-Las Vegas (UNLV) in the spring of 2012 and was a team manager for University of Utah Softball in 2010-11.

Tara began her collegiate playing career at SLCC where she earned SWAC Player of the Year honors as an outfielder and was named an NJCAA First Team All-American in 2008. Coach Bendt was a Distinguished Academic All-American at SLCC as well.

She then transferred to UNLV and led the Rebels in batting average in each of her two seasons hitting .379 as a junior in 2009 and closed out her collegiate campaign by hitting .382. For her performance, Bendt was named a First Team All-Mountain West Conference player in 2010 and was a two-time all-conference scholar athlete.

Bendt worked under Bennett as an assistant coach at Olympus High School from 2011-13. In addition to her duties on the Bruin Softball coaching staff, Coach Bendt is heavily involved in athletics promotions for SLCC.

She is a native of South Dakota and currently resides in South Jordan, UT.
