# Head Coach Todd Phillips

Head Coach Todd Phillips enters his sixth year as the SLCC Men's Basketball sideline general. Last year, Phillips led the Bruins to a 21-10 overall record while going 9-7 in conference. Salt Lake ended their season when they fell at the Region 18 Tournament.

In six full seasons leading the program, Phillips and his staff have moved 21 players on to compete and study at four-year schools. Last season, Coach Phillips placed four players on the All-Region 18 list. De'Sean Parsons won half of the Player of the Year honors and gained First-Team All-Region honors. Parsons moved on to play at Portland State. Blake Wilkinson received First-Team honors. Wilkinson is now playing at Brown University. Brandon Morley racked up Second-Team All-Region honors and Zerrion Payton received Honorable mentions and is now playing for Westminster College. The Bruins also sent Larry Okhomina to the European Pro League. He is now playing in Greece.

Todd became head coach at SLCC after serving three years as an assistant coach on the Bruin staff under legendary Head Coach Norm Parrish who is now the Head Coach at Westminster. Phillips spent eight seasons earning his stripes as an assistant coach for the Griffins at Westminster College beginning in 2000. In his time at Westminster, he helped lead the Griffins to eight 20-plus win seasons, six conference titles and six NAIA National Tournament berths. As a coach, Todd has seen his career come full circle.

Before getting into the profession, Phillips played basketball in the SWAC at one of SLCC's in-state rivals, Snow College. After graduating from Snow College, Phillips continued his playing career at Lewis and Clark State College from 1997-1999. He received his bachelor's degree in Education and Kinesiology, and earned a master's degree in Education Administration from the University of Utah.

He and his wife, Bobbi, are both originally from Boise, Idaho and have one daughter, Kinzi.



# **Assistant Coach Silas Mills**

Coach Silas Mills enters his fifth season as an assistant coach for SLCC Men's Basketball after helping the Bruins to another 20+ win season last year. He brings a wealth of collegiate and professional playing experience to the Bruin coaching staff.

During the 2015-16 year, Mills helped the Bruins to a 31-8 overall record while going 9-5 in conference and capturing the NJCAA National Championship. His primary focus is placed on player development. He works mainly with the Bruin post players but his ability to relate to the college basketball life makes it easy for him to have an impact on all players on the SLCC roster.

During his time at SLCC, Coach Mills has helped dozens of players move on to the next level including Tyler Rawson (Utah), Gibson Johnson (Hawaii), Gary Payton II (Oregon St, Milwaukee Bucks), and Neal Monson (UC Davis).

Silas began his collegiate playing career at the University of Utah under legendary Head Coach Rick Majerus. Coming in as a 'prop 48' student-athlete, Mills transferred to Salt Lake Community College where he played for legendary SLCC Head Coach Norm Parrish.

Mills carried the Bruins to an NJCAA National Tournament appearance and a top five ranking in the final national poll for the first time in program history. In 1993-1994, Mills guided the Bruins to a Region 18 championship and he was named an All-Region 18 player along with NJCAA All-Tournament honors.

He moved on to Utah State University and played under Larry Eustachy from 1994-1996. Silas led the Aggies to a Big West Conference championship as USU became the last program to claim the conference title.

Coach Mills entered the professional ranks overseas, beginning his pro career at Kalev Tallin in Estonia in 1996. He then played pro ball in the USBL and IBA in 1997-1998. In 1998, Mills joined the Mobiline squad in the Phillipino Basketball Association (PBA) where he carried them to a league championship and was named league MVP.

Mills then returned to the United States to play professionally in the CBA, where he led the Yakima Sun Kings to a league championship in 1999-2000. That year, Mills was named Finals MVP under Coach Paul Woolport. With the CBA title, Mills earned the opportunity to compete for the NBA's Cleveland Cavaliers in the annual Rocky Mountain Revue at Salt Lake Community College.

With a standout performance in the Revue, Mills earned a contract to play in the Turkish professional ranks where his pro career took flight. After a full year in the Turkish pro ranks with team Fenerbahce, Mills returned to the CBA where he played for multiple franchises over a three-year period before joining the Seattle Supersonics for another stint in the summer league. Silas has played professionally in the Greece, Italy, Spain, Argentina, Turkey and France over a period of a 14-year career

in Europe alone. He earned Most Dependable Player honors while in Europe (2003) by EuroBasket.com.

Mills closed his pro career with St. Chamond (France) following the 2010 season, where even at the age of 38 he averaged over 12 points per contest to go with 6.2 rebounds per outing and three blocks per game. He shot 47.3% from the field in his final year, with a three-point shooting average of 42.9% and a free-throw tally of 87.8%.

He received his bachelor's degree in Interdisciplinary Studies at Utah State University.



# **Assistant Coach Brian Swindlehurst**

Assistant Coach Brian Swindlehurst begins his third year with Salt Lake Community College after helping the team to yet another 20+ win season last year. He was also a pivotal part of the Bruins' National Championship run the year prior. His role includes academic advising, assisting with recruiting, opponent scouting, game planning, and individual skill training. Prior to coming to Salt Lake Community College, Coach Swindlehurst helped the Westminster College men's basketball program run their summer program and basketball camps.

Before his time at Westminster, Brian served as the Director of Basketball Operations, varsity assistant coach, and freshman head coach for Santa Margarita Catholic High School in Southern California, a high-level private school competing in one of the top high school leagues in

the country called the Trinity League. In 2014, he contributed to the varsity team winning a CIF championship in California Division 3AA.

During his time at Santa Margarita, he also helped run a club basketball program in Southern California called Back to Basics (B2B) that included youth teams from 6th grade all the way up to the high school varsity level.

Prior to coaching in California, Coach Swindlehurst spent six years as an assistant coach for the varsity boys basketball team at Timpview High School in Provo. He assisted the team that won the Utah state 4A championship in 2010. In addition to his duties with the varsity team, he was the head coach for various other teams during his time there (most recently the JV team).

Coach Swindlehurst has also been an assistant coach with the Utah Basketball Club AAU program.

As a player, Brian played at Timpview High School from 1999-2002. He was named Utah Valley's Most Valuable Player in 2002 and earned First Team All-State and Academic All-State awards.

In 2009, Brian graduated from Brigham Young University with a B.A. in Business Management emphasizing in Entrepreneurship.
