Head Coach Mark Davis

Mark Davis enters his third year at the helm of the SLCC men's and women's soccer programs after developing the program during the summer of 2016.

In his second year at the helm of SLCC Soccer, Davis lead the men's team to a 10-6-1 record, finishing second in the SWAC and third in the Region 18 Tournament. His women's team finished with a 10-5-1 record, finishing second in the SWAC and third in the Region 18 Tournament.

Davis has a long history of successful coaching at the collegiate level. The Utah native previously coached at BYU-Hawaii, working with the men's soccer program. He led his men's team to a .609 (15-8-9) overall winning percentage and .740 (15-3-7) percentage in the PacWest. His team has made a top four conference finish three seasons in a row achieving back-to-back-to-back winning seasons for the first time in school history. He was named the Pac-West Coach of the Year in 2013. Davis is the all-time winning coach in BYU-Hawaii men's soccer history.

Davis has strong ties in Utah, as he attended Copper Hills High School, where he started on the varsity squad all four years as a high school player. He is is a founder of Olympia Football Club in Heber City, Utah.

Davis was also a head coach of Real Salt Lake women's soccer team. He was named the head coach for the 2016 season. He was named UWS West Coach of the Year for his efforts during the 2016 season. In 2015 the RSL women won the WPSL Elite National championship.

He played at Iowa Western College and led the team to a conference championship in 2009. He went on to graduate from BYU-Hawaii and moved to Concordia University-Irvine where he gained his master's degree in coaching and athletic administration.

Davis served a two-year LDS mission in Tampico, Mexico 2006-08 and is fluent in Spanish. He is married to his wife, Natalie, and has two children - Dax and Rudy.



Assistant Coach Elton Jazexhiu

Elton Jazexhiu enters his third year as an assistant coach with the men's and women's soccer programs at Salt Lake Community College in 2019.

In 2018, Coach Jazexhiu was instrumental in helping both the men's and women's soccer programs at SLCC achieve their best records ever. The women won their Scenic West Athletic Conference title and Region 18 championship for the first time in program history while posting a record of 13-2-2. The men's team won their Scenic West Athletic Conference title for the second time in three years and made it to the Region 18 championship match for the first time in program history while posting a record of 15-3-1. Both teams were ranked Top Ten in the NJCAA national rankings and United Soccer Coaches' rankings.

Jazexhiu has been involved in coaching in the state of Utah for 15 years. He is currently a staff coach and the Director of Coaching for U8-U12 boys and girls at La Roca FC in Utah County. He has also been a staff coach for the Utah Olympic Development Program. Prior to joining La Roca, he was the Director of Coaching for Utah Arsenal SC from 2011 to 2014. From 2006 to 2008, Jazexhiu was the head coach of the Utah Valley University club team, amassing a record of 29-8-2 in his two years there.

Jazexhiu grew up in Tirana, Albania, where he played soccer with the youth program of FK Dinamo Tirana, one of Albania's premier professional clubs. He studied Exercise Physiology and Coaching at "Tirana Sports University" from 1992-1995. Elton graduated from BYU with a BA in International Studies in 2001. His love of foreign languages almost equals his love for the game of soccer.

Jazexhiu holds a Union of European Football Associations, UEFA A license, a U.S. Soccer National Youth License, and a U.S. Soccer C license. He resides in Saratoga Springs, Utah, with his wife, Jessica, and four children, Fiona, Alex, Ariana, and Erik.



Assistant Coach Jessica Duffin Evanson

Jessica Duffin Evanson was hired as the Goalkeepers Coach for the Salt Lake Community College Men's-and-Women's Soccer programs in the Summer of 2019. In the role, Evanson will work with the goalkeepers, while also focusing on assisting with defensive strategy and team management.

Jessica, a former All-Western Athletic Conference goalkeeper, helped lead Utah Valley University to its first-ever NCAA appearance as a student-athlete. She also worked as the goalkeeping coach at Utah Valley after her graduation.

A native of Logan, the former Jessica Duffin Evanson is the Director of Goalkeepers for Utah Arsenal FC. She is Utah Valley's all-time leader in career shutouts and earned the 2015 WAC Defensive Player-of-the-Year award with 76 saves. She holds two degrees from Utah Valley - a B.S. in Behavioral Science and a Master of Business Administration degree.






