

Head Coach Kyle Taylor

The program's first external hire since Norm Parrish in 1991, Taylor said the prestige of the SLCC program is what appealed to him

"Salt Lake Community College is one of the best NJCAA jobs in the country and I feel incredibly blessed to be the new head coach," he said. "From the first time I spoke with Kevin Dustin, I knew he was the type of visionary leader I wanted to work with. The tradition of excellence that Coach Parrish and Coach Phillips have established is tremendous, and I'm looking forward to building off their success. Salt Lake City is a great city to live in and recruit to. The college is in great hands under the leadership of President (Deneece) Huftalin."

Taylor most recently worked as the Associate Head Coach at Idaho State University. During his tenure with the Bengals, he worked as the program's offensive coordinator and also helped with skill development. Taylor also worked as the program's recruiting coordinator. Prior to that, Taylor worked for Utah State University under former coach Tim Duryea as his special assistant.

His previous head coaching experience came at Covenant College, where he was also the Director of Athletics for the NCAA Division-III institution in Georgia. While at Covenant, he led the team to their first NCAA tourney appearance and a school-record 18 wins after the 2016 season. In his role as Athletic Director, Taylor managed the budget, assisted with fundraising efforts for the institution, and successfully navigated a transition from NAIA to NCAA membership.

Taylor's coaching experience started in California at Pepperdine University, working as a video coordinator. He also worked as an operations director at Cal State Northridge. The California native earned an undergraduate degree from UCLA and a graduate degree from Northwest Missouri State University.

After working all levels of the coaching profession, Taylor said his program will be focused on several goals that range from academic achievement to player development.

"As far as the program goes, we are going to pursue championships on the court and help our players grow off the court as men," he said. "Insuring that student athletes receive their Associate degrees will be our top priority as coaches. We are going to continue to recruit high character and talented basketball players who will help us compete for Scenic West, Region 18 and National Championships. Player skill development will be a major component of our program, as well as assisting them in pursuing their dream of receiving a scholarship to a four-year school."

Taylor will be moving to the Wasatch Front to coach the Bruins with his own team. His wife, Shannon, and their three children – Kade, 10; Quinn, 8; and Phillip, 6 – will be joining Taylor shortly from Pocatello, where they have lived while he worked 6 with Idaho State.



Assistant Coach Brian Swindlehurst

CJ Killin joined the men's basketball staff at SLCC as Associate Head Coach in July 2020. He spent the previous season at Portland State following stops at Idaho State, Odessa College, and New Mexico Junior College before joining head coach Kyle Taylor's staff.

In his lone season at Portland State working under Viking coach Barret Peery, the Vikings won 18 games and finished fourth in the Big Sky Conference.

He spent the 2018-19 season at Idaho State under the direction of Bill Evans. While at ISU, CJ worked alongside current Bruins head coach Kyle Taylor. Killin spent the 2017-18 season at Odessa College (TX), where he helped the Wranglers to a 28-5 record, which included a 15-1 record in the WJCAC and an outright league championship. In all, CJ has helped 11 players move on to the Division I level in his lone season at Odessa.

He spent two seasons (2015-17) at New Mexico Junior College in Hobbs, New Mexico, helping 10 players continue their careers at the Division I level.

Before his time at NMJC, He served as an assistant coach at Peru State College where he helped the Bobcats to their most wins in over a decade.

Killin spent a season at Central Community College, helping the program reach the NJCAA D2 Final Four as well as coaching the NJCAA Player of the Year, Tyron Criswell.

CJ began his coaching career at his alma mater, Nebraska-Kearney, serving as a volunteer assistant coach from 2012-14. Killin, a native Nebraskan, earned his bachelor's degree from Nebraska-Kearney in 2014 and added a master's degree from Wayne State College in 2017. CJ is currently pursuing a second master's degree at Idaho State University.



Assistant Coach Ricardo Rush Jr.

Ricardo Rush enters his second season in 2020-21 with the SLCC Men's Basketball Program as an Assistant Coach after a successful 2019-20 inaugural season. He continues to build on his coaching expertise with the Bruin staff. Prior to joining SLCC Men's Basketball he led the on-court coaching and logistics for the DC Blue Devils while also assisting with recruiting and player evaluations. Rush has coached over 40 Division I basketball players for the DC Blue Devils under the Under Armour Circuit, including one McDonalds' All-American and Jordan Brand All-American. Rush also coached the number one draft pick for the 2017 NBA Draft, Markelle Fultz.

Rush served for 4 years as a Manager for the University of Maryland Mens' Basketball Team, under both Hall of Fame coaches, Gary Williams and current coach Mark Turgeon. After graduation Rush joined the staff of the Orlando Magic's Basketball Program, Basketball

Operations Department for 2 seasons. During that time he assisted with the NBA draft process and managed the SportVu data tracking system where he reviewed and analyzed player statistics and real time player and ball positioning. Rush is a native of Mitchellville, Maryland and graduated from The University of Maryland, College Park with a Bachelor's Degree in Sociology.
