

# Head Coach Kyle Taylor

Entering his third season in Bruins blue, Kyle Taylor has continued the strong tradition of the Salt Lake Community College Men's Basketball program.

In just two season, Taylor has posted an overall record of 49-9, earning back-to-back trips to the NJCAA Championships in Hutchinson, Kan. He earned the Scenic West Athletic Conference regular-season title and a Region 18 title in the 2019-20 season, seeing a high national seed end in disappointment with the COVID-19 pandemic. Taylor earned the 2020 Region 18 and NJCAA West District Coach-of-the-Year awards.

Not only has SLCC been successful as a team in Taylor's tenure, the Bruins have seen a great deal of individual success. To date, SLCC has had a pair of NJCAA All-Americans, eight NJCAA Academic All-America players, and has had 14 players accept offers to NCAA Division-I programs.

Taylor most recently worked as the Associate Head Coach at Idaho State University. During his tenure with the Bengals, he worked as the program's offensive coordinator and also helped with skill development. Taylor also worked as the program's recruiting coordinator. Prior to that, Taylor worked for Utah State University under former coach Tim Duryea as his special assistant.

His previous head coaching experience came at Covenant College, where he was also the Director of Athletics for the NCAA Division-III institution in Georgia. While at Covenant, he led the team to their first NCAA tourney appearance and a school-record 18 wins after the 2016 season. In his role as Athletic Director, Taylor managed the budget, assisted with fundraising efforts for the institution, and successfully navigated a transition from NAIA to NCAA membership.

Taylor's coaching experience started in California at Pepperdine University, working as a video coordinator. He also worked as an operations director at Cal State Northridge. The California native earned an undergraduate degree from UCLA and a graduate degree from Northwest Missouri State University.

"As far as the program goes, we are going to pursue championships on the court and help our players grow off the court as men," he said. "Insuring that student athletes receive their Associate degrees will be our top priority as coaches. We are going to continue to recruit high character and talented basketball players who will help us compete for Scenic West, Region 18 and National Championships. Player skill development will be a major component of our program, as well as assisting them in pursuing their dream of receiving a scholarship to a four-year school."

Taylor will be moving to the Wasatch Front to coach the Bruins with his own team. His wife, Shannon, and their three children – Kade, 10; Quinn, 8; and Phillip, 6 – will be joining Taylor shortly from Pocatello, where they have lived while he worked with Idaho State.

Salt Lake finished the 2018-19 season with a 20-9 record and a mark of 7-5 in the Scenic West Athletic Conference. The Bruins have won two national championships (2009 and 2016) and have won at least 20-games for 17 consecutive seasons.



# Assistant Coach CJ Killin

CJ Killin is in his second season as an assistant coach at Salt Lake Community College, having joined the staff in July 2020. He spent the previous season at Portland State, following stops at Idaho State, Odessa College, and New Mexico Junior College before joining head coach Kyle Taylor's staff.

In his lone season at Portland State, working under then-Vikings coach Barret Peery, the Vikings won 18 games and finished fourth in the Big Sky Conference. He spent the 2018-19 season at Idaho State under the direction of Bill Evans. While at ISU, CJ worked alongside current Bruins head coach Kyle Taylor.

Killin spent the 2017-18 season at Odessa College (TX), where he helped the Wranglers to a 28-5 record, which included a 15-1 record in the WJCAC and an outright league championship. In all, CJ helped 11 players move on to the Division I level in his lone season at Odessa. He spent two seasons (2015-17) at New Mexico Junior College in Hobbs, New Mexico, helping 10 players continue their careers at the Division I level.

Before his time at NMJC, Killin served as an assistant coach at Peru State College where he helped the Bobcats to their most wins in over a decade. Killin spent a season at Central Community College, helping the program reach the NJCAA Division-II national semifinals, as well as coaching the NJCAA Player of the Year, Tyron Criswell. CJ began his coaching career at his alma mater, Nebraska-Kearney, serving as a volunteer assistant coach from 2012-14.

Killin, a native of Nebraska, earned his undergraduate degree from Nebraska-Kearney in 2014 and added a graduate degree from Wayne State College in 2017. CJ is currently pursuing a second graduate degree at Idaho State University.



# **Assistant Coach Nick Covington**

Nick Covington enters his third season on the Salt Lake Community College Men's Basketball staff in 2021-22 as an assistant coach. In his first year at SLCC in 2019-20, he served as a player development coach following three seasons coaching the Utah Mountain Stars AAU program, and a 10-year professional playing career.

In three seasons beginning in 2017 with the Utah Mountain Stars based out of Salt Lake City, Covington helped produce ten Division-I scholarship players, including Michigan State center Mady Sissoko, who was the top prep center in the nation and the overall 43rd-ranked player in the Class of 2020.

Covington is no stranger to the junior college game. After a high school career at Little Rock Mills, he was recruited to play for the legendary Gene Bess, at Three Rivers Community College as a freshman. After playing his sophomore season at Southwest Community College under Verties Sailes, Covington then transferred to Weber State University for his junior

season.

As a senior in the 2006-07 season, playing under Ray Harper, Covington led a 30-2 Oklahoma City University to its fifth NAIA National Championship, shooting 44% from behind the three-point line. He earned NAIA Third Team All-America honors, along with First Team All-Sooner Conference honors.
