Head Coach Shay Goulding-Meurer

Shay Goulding Meurer was elevated to Head Volley-ball Coach in the spring of 2021, leading the Bruins for the second time in her esteemed career.

She was previously named the associate head coach of the Salt Lake Community College volleyball program in May of 2020. Goulding Meurer returns to SLCC after previously leading the Bruins as head coach from 2003-2007.

During her tenure as SLCC's head coach, she was a four-time NJCAA District I Coach-of-the Year and two-time AVCA West Region Coach-of-the-Year. Under her leadership, SLCC went to four NJCAA tournaments and graduated five NJCAA All-American players. In 2007, with a 44-2 record, her team was the NJCAA runner-up.

Goulding Meurer left the Bruins in 2008 to take the head coaching position at BYU, where she graduated three AVCA All-Americans and had a Top-20 recruiting class in 2011.

In 2012, Goulding Meurer founded 'UP Only High Performance Coaching' and over the last eight years has presented over 100 leadership workshops, coaching clinics, volleyball team camps and mindset boot-camps for coaches and student athletes at the club, high school and college level. The program also serves businesses and organizations coast-to-coast. She is also author of the book. 'From Skill Set to Mindset'.

Goulding Meurer played collegiate volleyball for Coastal Carolina University in South Carolina as a middle blocker and outside hitter. She was named team captain and the Chanticleer's 'Most Valuable Player'.

She earned a graduate degree in Exercise Science with an emphasis in Motor Learning and Sport Psychology from Utah State University in 2001. She also holds an undergraduate degree in History from BYU in 1998.

Goulding Meurer is from Visalia, California. She served as a volunteer missionary for The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-Day Saints in Santiago, Chile. She loves skiing, biking and has completed an 'Ironman' triathlon.

She is married to her best friend, John Meurer, and they have one son, Evan (2).



Assistant Coach Chris Tellesbo

Chris is entering his first season as an Assistant Volleyball Coach with Salt Lake Community College after spending the last seven years coaching at Skyline, Brighton, and Corner Canyon High Schools, contributing to five region titles and seven state tournament appearances.

He played club volleyball for Skyline High School, winning a club state championship his senior year, with all-state honors his junior and senior years. He went on to play three years of club for the University of Utah men's club team, and spent two of those years as a practice player with the Utah Women's Volleyball team.

Chris is a graduate of the University of Utah, with Bachelor's Degrees in Physics and Applied Mathematics, and a Master's Degree in Physics. His area of study was astrophysics and planetary dynamics, and spent a semester interning for NASA at Marshall Space Flight Center.







Assistant Coach Mackenzie Gromek

Mackenzie Gromek begins her 7th season on the SLCC Volleyball staff. Gromek graduated from Concordia University-Irvine in 2013, where she earned an undergraduate degree in psychology. Gromek is an Agoura Hills, California, native and began her playing career with Santa Monica Beach Club in 2004. She played her high school volleyball at Agoura High School, where she lettered all four years.

As an Eagle at Concordia, Mackenzie was a key player on the 2012 NAIA national championship team that went 38-0, also contributing to the 2011 national runner-up squad. Gromek was a member of the Eagles squad that set national records with a 76 match win streak between 2012-2013. The Eagles were Golden State Athletic Conference Champions from 2011-2013.

Gromek will focus on the development of middle blockers and overall team blocking. She will also be taking stats for the Bruins.
