Head Coach Shay Goulding-Meurer

Shay Goulding Meurer is leading the Bruins again for the second time in her esteemed career. She returned to SLCC in May of 2020 after previously leading the Bruins as head coach from 2003-2007.

Goulding Meurer led the Bruins to a mark of 22-6 during the 2021 season, including a record of 8-2 in Scenic West play. She was awarded the league's 'Coach-of-the-Year' for her coaching performance, which ended with a loss to national runner-up Snow College in the Region 18 tournament.

During her tenure as SLCC's head coach, she was a four-time NJCAA District I Coach-of-the Year and two-time AVCA West Region Coach-of-the-Year. Under her leadership, SLCC went to four NJCAA tournaments and graduated five NJCAA All-American players. In 2007, with a 44-2 record, her team was the NJCAA runner-up.

Goulding Meurer left the Bruins in 2008 to take the head coaching position at BYU, where she graduated three AVCA All-Americans and had a Top-20 recruiting class in 2011.

In 2012, Goulding Meurer founded 'UP Only High Performance Coaching' for volleyball coaches, and over the last eight years has presented over 100 leadership workshops, coaching clinics, volleyball team camps and mindset boot-camps for coaches and student athletes at the club, high school and college level. The program also serves businesses and organizations coast-to-coast. She is also author of the book, 'From Skill Set to Mindset'.

Goulding Meurer played collegiate volleyball for Coastal Carolina University in South Carolina as a middle blocker and outside hitter. She was named team captain and the Chanticleer's 'Most Valuable Player'.

She earned a graduate degree in Exercise Science with an emphasis in Motor Learning and Sport Psychology from Utah State University in 2001. She also holds an undergraduate degree in History from BYU in 1998.

Goulding Meurer is from Visalia, California. She served as a volunteer missionary for The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-Day Saints in Santiago, Chile. She loves skiing and biking, and has completed an 'Ironman' triathlon.

She is married to her best friend, John Meurer, and they have one son, Evan (4).

Assistant Coach Chris Tellesbo

Chris Tellesbo is in his second season as an assistant coach for the Salt Lake Community College Volleyball team. Tellesbo helped oversee a SLCC program that ranked as high as No. 3 in the NJCAA rankings during the 2021 season.

Salt Lake went 22-6 during the 2021 season, going 8-2 in the Scenic West Athletic Conference and winning the Scenic West title. The Bruins had a winning streak of 17 matches during the year.

Tellesbo contributed to SLCC sending three players to four-year scholarships, along with the Bruins leading the Scenic West in service strategy.

Off the court, Tellesbo is the program's lead for scouting, operations, and recruiting. He is a graduate of the University of Utah, with Bachelor's Degrees in Physics and Applied Mathematics, and a Master's Degree in

Physics. His area of study was astrophysics and planetary dynamics, and spent a semester interning for NASA at Marshall Space Flight Center.
